- (6) In order to be valid, this form, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed (or a notarially certified copy of such power or authority) must be lodged at the registered office of the Company, Unit 2005, 20th Floor, Cheung Kong Center, 2 Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong, not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting.
- (7) In the case of joint holders of any ordinary share, any one of such persons may vote, either personally or by proxy in respect of such ordinary share, provided that if more than one of such joint holders be present at the Meeting (or any adjournment thereof) personally or by proxy, the person whose name stands first in the register of members shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
- (8) The proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend the Meeting (or any adjournment thereof) in person to represent you.
